



Training to Support Carers of Palliative Care Patients

Carers Australia, in collaboration with Palliative Care Australia (PCA), are delivering training for workers who support carers of palliative care patients.

This training will aim to increase the knowledge and skills of counsellors and other health professionals who are working with carers caring for someone in palliative care.

The training is offered as two one-day workshops for two different audiences:

Day One – 1st December – 9am to 3.30pm

For counsellors and others working with carers of people in palliative care. Topics covered include:

- Advance Care Planning
- Interdisciplinary approach to palliative care services
- Understanding grief and loss
- Carers experience after the death of the person for whom they are caring

Day Two – 2nd December – 9am to 3.30pm

Incorporating PCA networks to aid health and community sector professionals working with carers of those in palliative care. Topics covered are as per Day One, with the addition of:

- Understanding the caring experience
- Challenges faced by carers and strategies to support them

The two days will be facilitated by Vic Dwyer from Silver Chain and Susan Abbott from Carers Australia. Certificates of Attendance will be provided to participants and may count towards professional development points.
