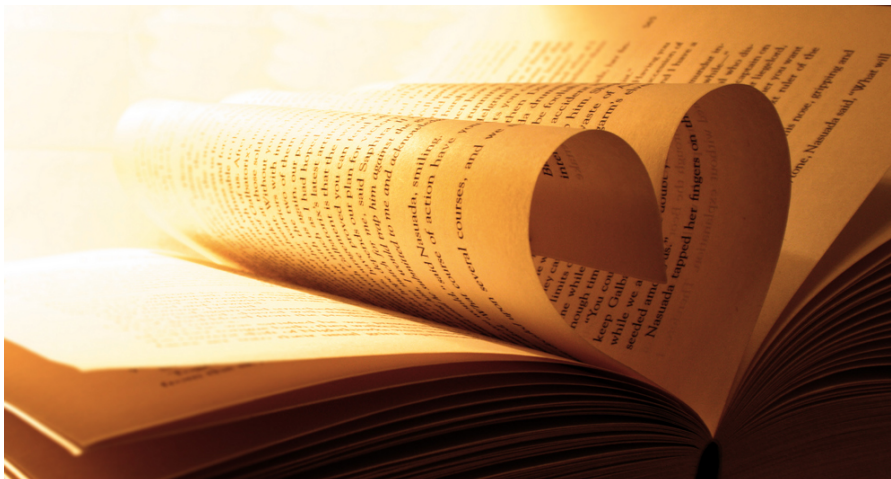

In palliative care, client biography combines life review, reminiscence, and life story published into the written form to become permanent records of reflections, events, memories, beliefs, values, for the patient/client and their family. A therapeutic biography service provides an opportunity for volunteer to meet with client and to record their life stories – oral histories, captured for future generations.

As a Volunteer Biographer the commitment is usually to visit a patient at home once a week for 4-6 weeks and to complete 1-2 biographies a year. No experience necessary and ongoing support, supervision and equipment provided.
